
My Anthem can provide you with access to health insurance costs and help you understand your health insurance usage.


Keep in mind that the My Anthem site seems to work best when using Internet Explorer as your browser.

You can access My Anthem by going too <a href="http://anthem.com">http://anthem.com</a> or by going to the Employee Links on our district home page, then selecting the HR Links option, and then selecting My Anthem from the links on the left menu bar.


When you go to the My Anthem site you will see the page below. If you have already registered, you can simply click on the Login button. If you have not registered, then click on the "Register" button.



Once you have logged on, you can go to My Claims to see your medical claims or pharmacy claims. This will allow you to see what the doctor or pharmacy charged, what the insurance paid, any provider "discount" (shown on your EOB as provider responsibility), and what your responsibility was.




Select "Medical Claims" to view your medical claims or "Pharmacy Claims" to view your pharmacy claims. You can search by date range to view claims.


