

## Accessing EBSCOhost on a Mobile Device

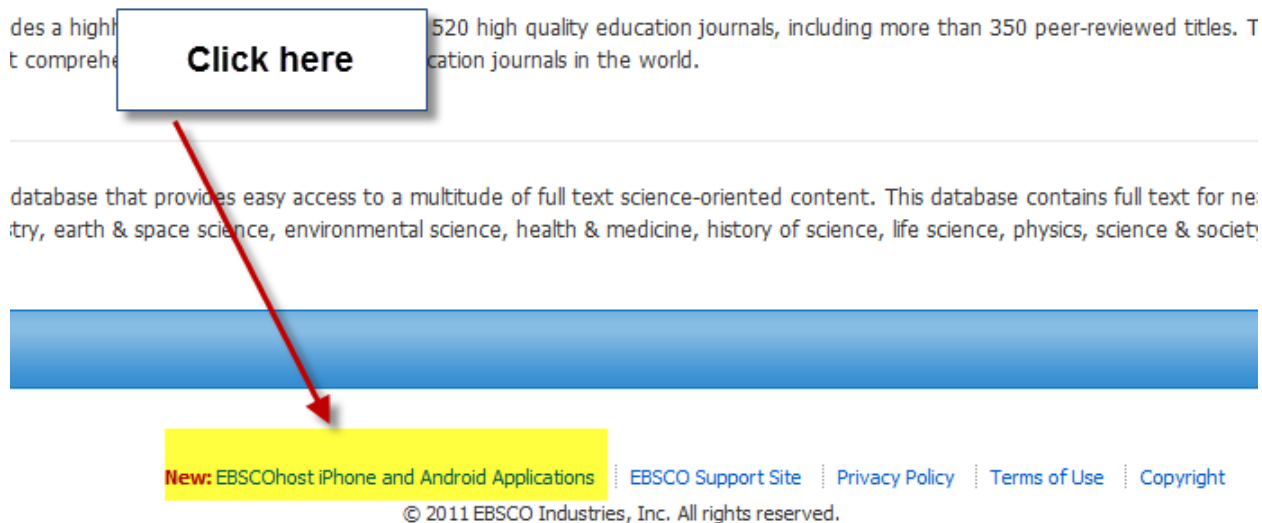
EBSCO Host uses an authorization key to provide access on Mobile Devices such as the iPhone and iPad. The mobile app is actually an iPhone app, but it works on you iPad. The authorization key will give you access for 90 days and then you will have to generate a new key. The authorization key is emailed to your mobile device. You can also use the web interface on your iPad. You need to have the EBSCOhost mobile app installed on your device before requesting an authorization key.

To generate a code, access EBSCOhost from the district website or log on from an offsite computer using the Remote Access Instructions. Once the key is generated, **you must view the email you receive on your device and click on the activation link within 24 hours.**

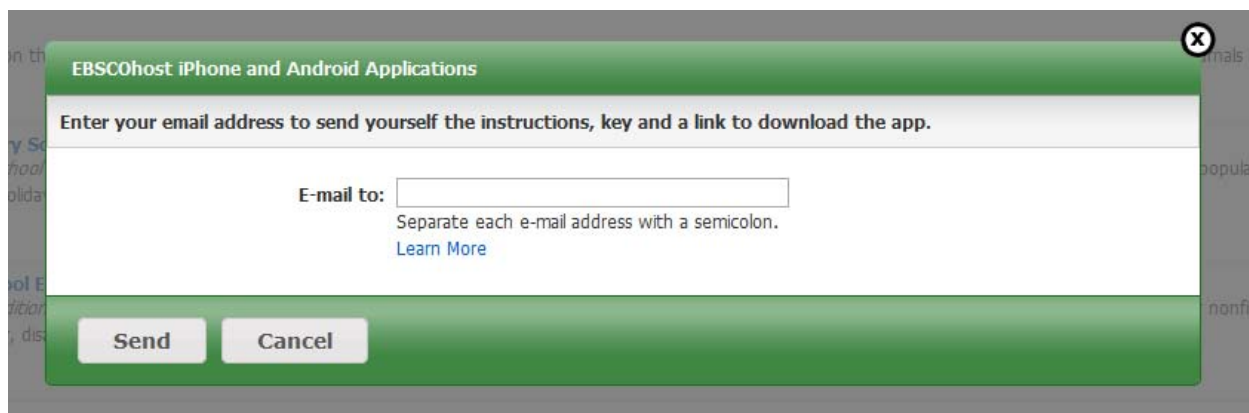
From the main EBSCOhost screen, select the main EBSCOhost Databases link.



This will open a list of databases. Scroll all the way to the bottom of the screen where you will see a link that says “EBSCOhost iPhone and Android applications”. Click on that link.



This will open a dialogue box asking for your email address. Enter your email address and click send. This will send an authorization key link to your email. To use the authorization key, YOU MUST VIEW THE EMAIL THAT IS SENT ON YOUR MOBILE DEVICE and you must have the EBSCOhost mobile application already installed.



The authorization is good for 9 months. Once the authorization expires, you will need to repeat the steps above to generate a new authorization link.
